## Exhibition on Banking – Report

- The Department of Commerce organized an exhibition in the school on July 23, 2019. A virtual Sobha Bank was created for making the students aware of the functioning of national, scheduled and co-operative banks. Ms. Kanaka Sathy Nair, the Principal, inaugurated The Sobha Bank. Class 12 commerce students perfected their roles of manager, tellers, clerks, insurance agents, security personnel, peons and PRO's. Attractive counters were set up for cash transaction, loans, insurance, reception, help desk etc. ATM and currency printing machine were the pick of the exhibition. Original slips for remittance and withdrawal of money were provided to educate students on bank transactions.
- Career opportunities for commerce students were displayed and explained by teachers. All the students, especially students from classes 9 to 12 were given the opportunity to visit the bank and experience its functioning by taking part in various activities. The exhibition was conducted by the teachers of the Commerce Department & the Art Department.
